## Andante

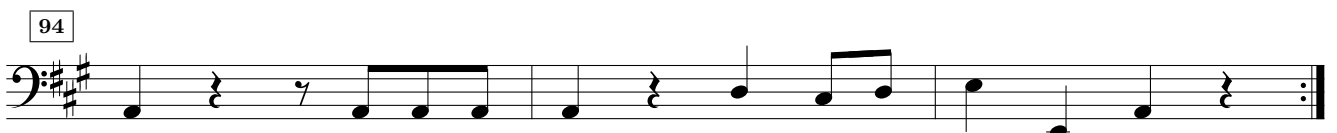
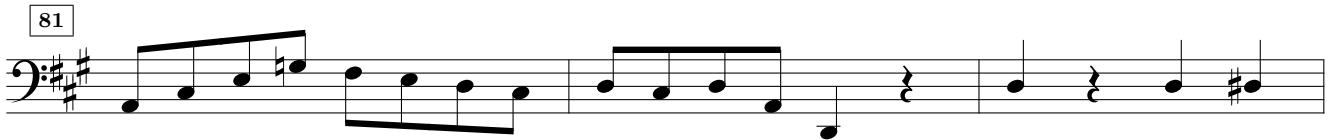
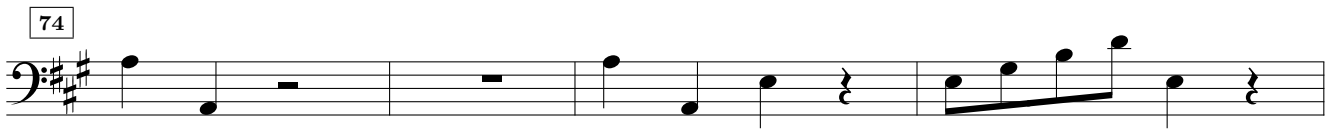
